GPS tracking involves a device that uses the global positioning system of satellites to determine the precise location of the animal. Locations are then logged to the device and can be downloaded in various ways.

Lotek created the first GPS Collar in 1995 and now have a wide range of collars using various GPS technologies. All Lotek collars have replaceable battery packs, built-in VHF beacons, programmable VHF and GPS schedules, unlimited customer support and a full one-year warranty.

Collars available through Biotrack start at a weight of only 190 grams and locations can be logged as often as every 15 minutes. Collar types currently available from Biotrack include store-on-board collars and remote download by UHF, GSM or Argos.
